Please note that the school and office will be closed during Easter Break, April 10th-17th. The office will reopen and classes will resume Tuesday, April 18th.

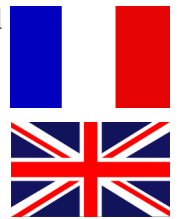
Announcements
