SAT: The SAT registration deadline for the May 7th test is Friday, April 8. To register, go to:

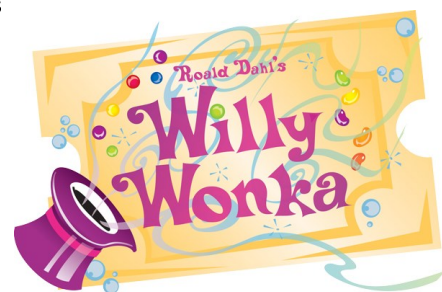
