Exams are given in English and biology, and students can choose to take a Spanish exam. Students should allow approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes for the exams.

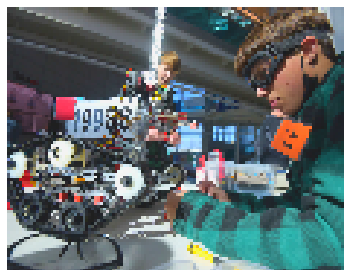
