Theater Camp Junior! This camp will last for two weeks! Monday- Friday, July 24- Aug 4 from 9:00am-11:00am. This is for campers who have completed Kindergarten-Second grade. Campers will learn basic theater concepts, learn songs and dances in the Little Mermaid Jr.

Max is 25. Cost is \$115 or \$105 for summer daycare students.

Theater Camp Senior. This camp will be for friends going into 3rd-completing 8th grade. Campers will help with Junior campers, where they will learn the songs and dances, then they will work the rest of the day on the production, lines, costumes, and scenery for The Little Mermaid Jr. Auditions will be held the first day of camp. Everyone gets a part, we just won't know which part until after the first day. Please pack a lunch, hot lunches will be offered on select days for \$3.50.

Camp meets from 9:00-3:00 M-F July 24th-Aug. 4th. Cost is \$195 or \$185 for summer daycare students.

Students of both camps will get a SEA Camp shirt and a Little Mermaid Jr. shirt. Performance will be Friday August 4th at 7:00 pm. We may need to add a second show on Saturday afternoon depending on ticket sales. Both camp's campers must commit to all shows and practices.
