AREAS OF FOCUS

Helping students become productive citizens in the classroom and beyond. This includes skills ranging from conflict management to interview skills to relational skills such as how to connect with people off screens.

3. Spiritual leadership

Working with students who are interested in growing their skills in Christian leadership, including through a peer ministry program where students learn skills such as how to lead Bible studies, how to lead a mission trip, and how to pray for and support their peers.
