



Our Student Success Center is growing! We are now open three days a week and alreadyhave had more than 250 visits from students who need help with their homework, a quiet place to study, someone to listen to their problem and provide help to find solutions.

#### What is the Student Success Center?

A place for students who want help to grow their academic skills, get assistance workingthrough problems with others, find emotional support and a listening ear, and (when desired) getpractical help for life's situations.

#### Resources available in the Student Success Center:

- A friendly face and someone to listen
- Support for students struggling emotionally
- One-on-one and small group tutoring
- Self-directed therapeutic art and music
- Calming activities to help with anxiety
- Healthy food for those who cannot afford/have forgotten their food

#### Please come to the Student Success Center to:

- Get help with homework/studying or get edits on a paper you have written (academic help)
- Talk over a problem you are having with others (relational help)
- Find help when you are struggling emotionally (emotional help)
- Access certain accommodations from your ISP (testing support)
- Plan a FUEL presentation (spiritual leadership development)

#### When to come to the Student Success Center:

- Large problem—Immediately (You feel unsafe. You or someone you know is in danger. This is an emergency!)
- Medium problem that CANNOT wait Immediately (A classmate is repeatedly being unkind to you. You feel very sad and coping strategies are not working.)
- Medium problem that CAN wait during study hall, homeroom, lunch, after school
- Small problem (You are in a conflict with a friend. You feel stressed about school. You feel angry and need help coping) during study hall, homeroom, lunch, after school

## Because we need this space and resources for students in need, please refrain from coming to the Student Success Center if:

- You just don't want to go to class or your friend is in there and you want to hang out
- It's Monday or Friday (the center is closed those day)
- Because you have an unhealthy sweet tooth and there's candy in there

**NOTE:** If the center is empty, students are welcome to come during their study hall to study or use the self-guided resources. Please know, however, that you may need to go back to study hall if a pressing matter arises.
